- Rich young man and his 4 mistakes
 - o He did not recognize Jesus for who He was
 - CS Lewis Jesus was either a liar, lunatic or the Son of God
 - He did not realize his own faults
 - He did not understand what was lacking knowing God
 - He did not understand the grace of God
 - He focused on what He had not done not what God had
 - He gave up and went away
 - We are always the ones to turn our backs on God
- A very personal account relating to a situation occurring right now in our family

What God has been speaking to my heart over these last 2 days

- 1. We are promised nothing beyond this moment
 - o Rom. 11:34 "Who has known the mind of the Lord? Or who has been his counselor?"

 - c. What are you believing God for in your life that needs a breakthrough?
