Not Just Surviving But Winning Introduction Ephesians 6:10-20

- As a Christian today we are engaged in a battle that has been raging since the dawn of time.
- The origin of Satan and the battle we face Isaiah 14:12-14
 - o Prophesy against the king of Babylon
 - Satan was thrown out of heaven for wanting to be like God v.14 Pride v.13
- Also Ezekiel 28:12-15
 - Prophesy against the king of Tyre but also that same description found in Isaiah
 - o Present in the Garden of Eden
 - V. 14 Guardian cherub the cherubim are the angelic beings who proclaim and protect the glory of God
 - Guarded the entrance to Eden (Gen. 3:24)
 - Instructed by God to be placed on the lid of the Ark of Covenant (Ex 25:18)
 - Same described by Ezekiel in his vision as the "Living Creatures" (Ez 1)
- In the garden of Eden God puts into motion the conflict we would always have with Satan (Gen 3:14-15)
 - Satan is present at creation as the morning star
 - o But by the garden he is already fallen
 - o God places enmity (mutual, active hatred for...)
 - o The die is cast for the ongoing battle between Satan and the children of God but the promise is given of victory (v 15)
- What is this battle being fought for?
 - o **For our mind** worry, anxiety, fear, despair, doubt, depression, vain imagination
 - (Dan.10:12) Then he continued, "Do not be afraid,
 Daniel. Since the first day that you set your mind to

gain understanding and to humble yourself before **your** God, **your** words were heard, and I have come in response to them.

- o For our hearts possessiveness, ungodly affections, greed
 - (Psa 119:30) I have chosen the way of truth; I have set my heart on your laws.
 - (Psa 119:32) I run in the path of your commands, for you have set my heart free.
- o **For our bodies** unhealthy lifestyles, immoral behavior, immodesty
 - (Rom 8:10) But if Christ is in you, your **body** is dead because of sin, yet your spirit is alive because of righteousness.
- o For our soul salvation
 - (I Pet5:8) Be self-controlled and alert. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour.
- Matthew 12:30 Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.
- The author of Ephesians 6 had a unique perspective to his use of descriptive terms
 - o Paul was in prison when he wrote this
 - most likely in Rome and only a few years from his death
 - o Ephesians is one of the pastoral epistles written to churches to encourage, correct and instruct.

- Paul could visually see the items the soldiers wore and used those to describe what we needed in order to do battle in the spirit.
- God's plan, from the very beginning of time, was to provide a way for you and for me to come to know Him and spend eternity with Him.
- In the meantime He desires for His children to be overcomers
 - o Not just survive, but WIN!
