Spotting the Counterfeit – Part 2

I Samuel 13:5-14

REVIEW

- 1. Where do we see counterfeit in the Bible?
 - First Garden of Eden Genesis 3:1-6
 - A counterfeit is a lie
 - Satan lied to Eve and caused her to substitute the truth with a lie
 - The purpose of a counterfeit is to cause a person to believe something that is not true
 - Satan brought a counterfeit to the truth of what God had created
 - He is doing the same thing today, but always remember, he is *clever not creative*
- 2. Effective counterfeits cannot be easily spotted
 - Satan will take what is genuine and twist it just enough to keep it looking real but in reality it is a fake and NOT WHAT GOD DESIRES FOR YOU
 - Do we always have to fall for the counterfeit?
- Anything that God does or has done satan wants to twist, pervert and bring a counterfeit to keep us from having in our lives all that God desires Why? 6 reasons
 - 1. If we live with counterfeit we live with lies
 - 2. It keeps us from true fellowship with the Father
 - 3. To discourage us from a promise that we have been given
 - 4. It keeps our churches focused on things that are not important
 - 5. It dulls our hearts to the sin of the world and the lost
 - 6. It weakens our power in the Holy Spirit
- How can I spot a counterfeit?

1. Does it sit well in my spirit?

- A Christian has the Holy Spirit as a guide to living our lives IF WE WILL LISTEN!
 - When we become a child of God He does not remove our ability and privilege to choose
 - We can listen to the voice of the HS or we can choose to ignore it
- John 14-16— the disciples are distressed that Jesus said He is leaving them, but He will send the Advocate; the Counselor
- John 16:13 But when he, the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all truth.
 - Jesus sent the Holy Spirit specifically to encourage, strengthen and guide us
 - Do we listen to the Holy Spirit or do we call it what the world calls it?

- o intuition
- A feeling
- o Gut reaction
- Spider Sense
- The unbeliever does not have the Holy Spirit within him/her
- That is why you must so carefully guard who you allow to speak into your life give you advice, direction, or counsel
- The unsaved do not speak with the guidance and direction of the Holy Spirit

2. What do others say?

- If anyone who truly loves you is offering a counter opinion to what you want LISTEN TO THEM
- The Holy Spirit will often work through other people
- Why should you listen to the counsel of the godly?
- John 10:27 My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me.
 - The sheep knew the master's voice because it was familiar
 - We can only know the voice of Jesus, the voice of the Holy Spirit, if we spend time with Him
 - And His voice will often sound like a family member, a spouse, your children, or your pastor

3. Are you not acting like yourself as you decide?

- When you are not being led by the Lord your demeanor, your personality, your very nature can be altered
 - I Samuel 13 Saul does something very out of character
 - In I Samuel 10:8 Samuel told Saul to go to Gilgal and wait for him 7 days to come and offer the sacrifice and give God's instructions
 - o **READ** I Samuel 13:5-14
 - I Samuel 28 Saul does it again after Samuel's death and hires a witch to summon the ghost of Samuel
 - o Saul knew better but he was not acting like himself
 - o God rejected Saul and his family in favor of David
 - Walking out of God's will even in the time of greatest frustration will carry even greater consequence

4. Do you increase or decrease your prayer regarding the decision?

- Honest prayer will reveal the true nature of what you are considering
- Asking God directly if what you are dealing with is real or counterfeit positions your heart to see clearly
- I Samuel when Saul or David asked God what they should do they were victorious in their battles
- 5. If you do not get what you want, when you want it, are you willing to continue waiting on God?

- Asking God means I give up my desires and my timetable for His
- Asking God means sometimes not getting what I want but knowing that He loves me and wants the best for me
- But waiting on the genuine of God by recognizing the counterfeit means that you receive a greater blessing
- Why? Because it is from God and is genuine

We would be amazed at how much we have missed in our lives due to our impatience, greed and pride.

- 1. Moses did not get to enter into the promised land because he allowed his pride to rise up Numbers 20:12
- 2. David's family was a house divided because of his disobedience to God's law 2 Samuel 12:10
- 3. Saul lost the kingdom and his throne due to his impatience and unbelief I Samuel 13:14
- 4. Many of the churches of the NT struggled and suffered because they believed counterfeit teachings about Jesus and God's love

Good News: God will always be glorified and victorious

- 1. Even when I have been led astray and fooled by the counterfeit, recognizing what I did is the first step to putting God back first in your life
 - That does not necessarily mean the circumstances or consequences will be altered
 - What it means is that WE change and God can work through us despite the situation we have put ourselves in
- 2. God's love for us does not change
 - I John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.
 - God will always forgive a repentant heart
